Exhibition Summary. The University Heights Arts Association produces mini-exhibitions at Queen City Imaging (3100 Main Street in Buffalo) as part of their Art Partnering Program, which places art in local businesses throughout Western New York.

GUIDELINES

Open to photography and digital prints. Items must be original, framed according to our guidelines, and ready to hang.

Number of Entries. For this mini-exhibition, 3-5 works of art may be displayed, depending on the size of the work.

Eligibility. These exhibitions are open to:

- 1) members of the UHAA
- 2) residents of Western New York
- 3) guest artists from beyond Western New York

Sales and Display of Works. Artists are invited to sell their exhibited work. Neither the UHAA nor Queen City Imaging charge a fee for sold work. Sales take place at the close of the exhibition. Exhibited works must be retrieved from the UHAA at Queen City Imaging at the close of the exhibition.

Exhibition Tags. The UHAA will print exhibition tags containing information about each work of art. All tags include a QR cell phone code containing additional information about the art, the artist, the exhibition, Queen City Imaging, and the UHAA Art Partnering Program. Prices will be added to the exhibition tags if the work is for sale.

Advertising. The UHAA will develop and print a poster and postcard annually advertising all of the Queen City Imaging exhibitions for a calendar year. An additional poster and postcard will be designed for each exhibition. A complimentary print copy of all posters and the postcard will be given to exhibiting artists. PDF files of all printed material will be made available to artists who wish to print copies on their own. Exhibitions are extensively advertised through through local media.

Entry Fee. Free.

Liability. Neither the University Heights Arts Association nor Queen City Imaging assumes liability for loss or damage of work. Artists are invited to insure their own work.

Schedule: Exhibitions last for approximately three months.
